Certificate IV in Companion Animal Services

Those who complete the seminar are invited to continue in a study program which incorporates a range of written and practical training assignments, culminating in a 6 day workshop program in NSW which provides in-depth information and training. Those who wish to continue to become a qualified trainer may then complete the remaining course work.

Graduates who complete the **Certificate IV** course can apply to become a member of the Delta Professional Dog Trainers Association (DPDTA), which provides the professional development and accreditation for **Delta qualified instructors**.
